How to Clean Fabrics

Cleaning
bouclé fabric
– step by step.

1



Vacuuming (regularly)

Ideally once a week.



Use a soft vacuum cleaner attachment to gently remove dust and particles from the surface.



Do not use a turbo brush.

2



Gentle spot cleaning

for fresh stains:



Remove excess dirt using a cloth, spoon, etc. For ketchup or other semi-liquid stains, the most important thing is quick removal and avoiding rubbing the substance into the fabric.



Use a **damp cloth with lukewarm water** and a small amount of mild detergent. Clean the stain gently in circular motions.

Recommended product: OA Sofa Care

How to use:

Shake before use. Test the product on a hidden area. Spray the surface from approx. 10–20 cm and leave for about 30 seconds to allow the product to penetrate. Then clean thoroughly using a damp microfiber cloth. Remove the excess with a clean, dry microfiber cloth. Dry the area with a towel and allow it to dry completely.

What to avoid when caring for bouclé fabric?



STRONG RUBBING

It may damage loops and cause pilling.



ROUGH BRUSHES OR HARD SPONGES

They can damage the bouclé structure.



OVER-WETTING THE FABRIC

Excess water may deform fibers and create stains.



HARSH DETERGENTS AND BLEACH

They can discolor or damage the fabric.



VACUUM CLEANERS WITHOUT A SOFT ATTACHMENT

When cleaning and staining, use only a light, gentle application – touch, do not scrub.



DRYING WITH HOT AIR

Avoid dryers and heaters; let the fabric dry naturally.

CAUTION:
Radiators can cause discoloration.
