How to Clean Fabrics

Cleaning
chenille fabrics
– step by step.

1



Vacuuming (regularly)



Use a soft vacuum cleaner attachment to remove dust and particles. Always vacuum gently to avoid damaging the soft chenille fibers.



Do not use a turbo brush.

Gentle spot cleaning

for fresh stains:



Gently blot fresh stains with a paper towel or soft cloth (do not rub).

Use a damp cloth with lukewarm water and a little mild detergent, then gently wipe the stain in a circular motion.



Allow the cleaned area to dry at room temperature.

Recommended product: **OA Sofa Care**

How to use:

Shake before use. Test the product on a hidden area. Spray the surface from approx. 10–20 cm and leave for about 30 seconds to allow the product to penetrate. Then clean thoroughly using a damp microfiber cloth. Remove the excess with a clean, dry microfiber cloth. Dry the area with a towel and allow it to dry completely.

What to avoid when caring for chenille fabric?



RUBBING AND INTENSE SCRUBBING

Chenille may pill or stretch.



ROUGH BRUSHES AND HARD SPONGES

They can mechanically damage the fabric.



OVER-WETTING THE FABRIC

It may cause deformation or water marks.



STRONG DETERGENTS AND BLEACH

Avoid solvents or chemicals not intended for upholstery.



VACUUMING WITHOUT A SOFT ATTACHMENT

When caring for and cleaning stains, use only a soft, gentle tip – touch, do not scrub.



DRYING ON A RADIATOR OR WITH HOT AIR

It may damage the fibers and discolor the fabric.
